All bread runs operate on a first come, first served basis.

Cornerstone United Reform Church of Edmonton (11610 95 A street)

Provides free bread on a first come first serve basis.

Saturday 9:15 a.m. to 9:45 a.m.

Dickensfield Amity House (9213 146 Ave.)

Provides free bread while supplies last.

Mondays: Doors open at 11:00 AM

Fridays: Doors open at 9:00 AM

Freedom Centre Bread Run (4925 134 Ave.)

Provides day-old bread, pastries, fresh vegetables and sometimes other food items.

Wednesdays from 9:30 a.m. to 11 a.m. (CLOSED August)

Garneau-Strathcona Food Security (7909 82 Ave. – Spirit of Hope United Church)

Provides prepacked bags containing a variety of foods including fruits, vegetables, dairy products, bread and canned foods available for pickup.

Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. (Please arrive by 7:45)

Mill Woods United Church Bread Run (15 Grand Meadow Crescent)

Provides day old bread, a variety of fruits and vegetables.

Saturdays 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m.

Southside Church of the Nazarene (10712 29 Ave NW)

Provides free bread and other day-old products.

Based on a lottery system, while supplies last.
