All bread runs operate on a first come, first served basis.

Cornerstone United Reform Church of Edmonton (11610 95A St)

Provides free bread on a first come first serve basis.

Saturday 9:15 am to 9:45 am

Dickensfield Amity House (9213 146 Ave)

Provides free bread while supplies last. Please bring your own bag when coming in.

Mondays: Doors open at 11:00 am (Distribution time may vary)

Fridays: Doors open at 9:00 am (Distribution time may vary)

Freedom Centre Bread Run (4925 134 Ave)

Provides day-old bread, pastries, fresh vegetables and sometimes other food items.

Wednesdays from 9:30 am to 11 am (CLOSED August)

Garneau-Strathcona Food Security (7909 82 Ave at Spirit of Hope United Church)

Provides prepacked bags containing day-old bread and other items, which may include fruits, vegetables or dairy products, depending on availability.

Saturdays from 8:00 am - 9:30 pm

Mill Woods United Church Bread Run (15 Grand Meadow Crescent)

Provides day old bread, a variety of fruits and vegetables.

Saturdays 8:30 am – 9:30 am

Southside Church of the Nazarene (10712 29 Ave NW)

Provides free bread and other day-old products.

Based on a lottery system, while supplies last.
